Braishfield Parish Council has considered the application and wishes to object on the following basis:

- Principally to the extension of hours, due to noise of lorry movements and tipping of scalpings, which is heard by residents on the west and south of Braishfield. Further, if the Borough Council proceeds with the Gypsies and Travellers site that they are proposing to locate in Bunny Lane, the residents of the site would be adversely affected;
- And secondly to the increase in maximum vehicle movements from 208 to 400 movements per day, due to noise, mess and the current poor condition of the road surfaces.
