The Clerk reported on a interview he had
had with Mr. Hoddinott with regard

Mr Hoddinott stated that he did not
own property on the Right of Way opposite

With regard to the Bus Shelter Mr Hoddinott
explained the position that he did not
want to convey the Ground on which
the Shelter was standing but was
prepared to enter into an agreement with
the Council to have the use of the Ground
but reserving the right subject to notice
to move the Shelter if he so desired
After discussion it was agreed that the
Clerk should write to Mr Hoddinott and
the matter be again considered at the
next meeting

School
Hedge

Mr Greenwood reported that he had
raised the matter of cutting the school
hedge at the Managers Meeting and
the question was being taken up with

the Sanitation Authority.

W. Botbold reported that there was a dangerous tree in Common Road and the Clerk was directed to report the matter to the Surveyor.

The use of the ground on which it had been suggested that Lavages be erected was again considered and the Clerk was instructed to write to the District Council and suggest that it be a site for sale as in its present condition it was an eyesore.

The Clerk reported that he had received a letter with regard to the transfer of boxes and box charity from the Clerk to the Sheffield Lyfch Parish Council.

The Clerk was directed to report again after the matter had been considered by the Micklethwait Parish Council.

It was reported that the footpaths opposite the Dog & Brook had been trimmed by the County Council Roadman. The Clerk was directed to make enquiries as to this.
