

Minutes of a meeting of the Council held at the Social Club Braeshfield on Monday the 11th January 1960 at 8pm Present:- Severein A H Lansdowne Chairman: Mrs D C Bacon Mrs W Willett Miss J. Parsons & Mr J. H. W. Wyllet with the District Council Reps Mr R. Brown.

Before the commencement of the meeting the Chairman gave New Year Greetings to the Council.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Mr Wyllett Mr J. Parsons reported that the report in the Herald had been read and after discussion it was agreed that the Club should see Mr Alford and after obtaining the necessary information should communicate the information to the police to warn the offenders.

Mrs Bacon The Club reported that he had been in communication with the District Surveyor who was prepared to set a committee of the Council. It was agreed that Mr Wyllett and Mr W. Willett should meet Mr Plumb.

Mrs Bacon Mrs Bacon reported that at the request of the Council she had attended the local Inquiry in respect of an appeal

made by Strong to against the refusal to permit the erection of buildings on land opposite the Wheatstone Farm. Miss Bacon stated that she had represented the Council views but that she thought that the views against the development had been very poorly stated. A vote of thanks to Miss Bacon was passed.

The Chairman again stated his views with regard to the cancelling of meetings and the circumstances leading to the cancelling of the November meeting. On the proposition of Mr. Robb seconded by Mrs. Baker a vote of confidence in the Chairman was agreed.

Mr. Brown stated that the dwellings now being built would be completed at an early date and prospective tenant should be selected. It was agreed that a meeting should be held for this purpose at Speaney Cottage on Thursday the 21st January 1960 at 8 pm.

The Clerk reported that Mr. Brown had been elected County Councillor for the Northport Division which included the Parish of Braeshfield.
