Monday the 5th September 1960 at 8pm

Minutes of the meetings held on the 2nd May
9th June and 11th July were read and
confirmed

The Club read a letter from Mr Club
with regard to the access near Brook Bridge
which stated that the matter had been
brought to the notice of the Area Planning
Office

The Club reported that since the last
meeting held had been a communication
with Mrs Bacon with regard to the
Bus Service and that he had
written unofficially to the Traffic
Manager of the Bus Company and had
made certain suggestions. The Traffic
Manager had thanked him for the suggestions
the action of the Club was approved.

The Club read the specification of the
work to be carried out at the old
Council houses that had been
obtained by Mr Brown and which
appeared to be quite comprehensive

Mr. Brown reported that the seat in the
 shelter had been damaged and we in
 a bad state. Owing to the fact that
 the shelter was little used as a bus
 shelter it was agreed that the seats
 be removed.

The Chairman asked about the house
 being built on Mr. Jones' land and
 Mr. Brown stated that he thought
 planning permission had been obtained
 many years ago.

It was agreed that the next meeting of
 the Council be held on October 3rd
 and that the question of the Reservoir Hedge
 be placed on the Agenda.
