

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Braithfield Parish Council held

Minutes The Minutes of the Meeting held
on Monday 6th March were read &
approved.

Matters Arising

- (i) The Clerk reported that he had
spoken to the police regarding
the cars in Hill View Road. They
were looking into the matter.
- (ii) Regarding the complaint about
noise from the garage, the
Clerk said that he had spoken
to Mr. Watkins & that he had
said that he thought he was
not making unreasonable noise.
It was decided to let this matter
rest.

Correspondence There was none.

Points raised at the Annual Parish Meeting

- (a) The Council resolved that the Parish of Braishfield should if possible be linked with Castleigh in the Local Government Reorganisation.
- (b) The Clerk was asked to write to Mr. Bennett regarding the drop from the kerb outside School House. The Clerk was further instructed to find out if it would be possible to have a pull-in for the bus at this point.
- (c) The Clerk was asked to find out if a hedge could be planted along the new fence line in Rousey Road.
- (d) The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. Bennett & find out when the footway was to be completed, & also to ensure that something was done about the ditch outside the house of Mr. G. Munnelwhite.
- (e) The Council were not in favour of any street lights in the village.
- (f) The Clerk was instructed to write to the H.C.C. & find out what was happening about the proposed speed limit.
- (g) The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. Ollivant & tell him to remove the barbed wire obstructing

- the footpath.
- (h) The Council decided to leave the question of a donation towards the repair & maintenance of the War Memorial until the cost was known.
 - (i) The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. Bennett & ask him to clean out the pond near Pond Cottages again.
 - (j) The Council decided to leave the question of naming of roads for the time being.

Any other Business There was none.

Next Meeting The date for the next meeting was fixed for Monday 1st May, 1972 at 8 p.m.

There being no further business, the Chairman closed the meeting.
